

## Adjectives Worksheet | Alliterations (sentences)

**Alliteration** is when two or more words start with the same sound. It makes sentences fun to say and hear! For example: "Silly seals" is alliteration because both words start with the "s" sound. "Thin tiger" is not alliteration because "th" and "t" make different sounds.
