

Verbs Worksheet | Irregular verbs

A **verb** is a word that tells what someone or something does. It can show an action, like *run*, *eat*, or *jump*, or a state of being, like *is* or *was*. Some verbs change in the past tense in a special way. For example, *go* changes to *went*, and *see* changes to *saw*. These are called **irregular verbs** because they don't just add *-ed* like regular verbs.
