


Adverbs Worksheet | Adverbs and adjectives

An **adverb** tells us how, when, or where something happens. Adverbs usually describe verbs (action words). An **adjective** is a word that tells us what something sounds like, looks like, smells like, or tastes like. Adjectives describe nouns (people, places, animals or things).
