

Sentences Worksheet | Sentence, fragment or run-on?

A **full sentence** expresses a complete thought (it has a subject and a verb). A **fragment** is not a complete thought. A **run-on** sentence has two or more clauses that are not joined correctly.



Instructions: Rewrite the fragments and run-ons as proper sentences. If it's already a proper sentence, simply write the word 'sentence'.
