

## Adjectives Worksheet | Identifying adjectives

**Adjectives** are words that describe nouns. They tell us more about a person, place, or thing by giving details about size (tiny, huge), color (blue, red), shape (round, square), feeling (happy, nervous), or other qualities (soft, shiny, delicious).
