

Sentences Worksheet | Simple to compound sentences (with connecting word)

A **compound sentence** is made when two or more simple sentences are joined together with a conjunction (a connecting word) such as 'and,' 'but,' 'so' and 'because'.



Instructions: Combine each pair of sentences using the word in parentheses.

1. Vince played outside. He met a new friend. (*and*)

Vince played outside, and he met a new friend.

2. Jennifer finished her book. She started a new one. (*so*)

3. The puppy barked loudly. It wanted attention. (*because*)

4. Lucy went to the park. She forgot her ball. (*but*)

5. Timmy went swimming. He brought his goggles. (*so*)

6. Sally drew a picture. She colored it with crayons. (*and*)

7. Mom made dinner. Dad cleaned the dishes. (*and*)

8. Alex rode his bike. He wore his helmet. (*so*)
