1. experience
- Personal encounter or involvement in a situation or event.

2. scar
- A mark left on the skin after an injury heals.
 - A magical symbol with special powers.

3. assist
- To hinder or interfere with someone's progress or success.
 - To help or support someone in accomplishing something.

4. scatter
- To gather or collect things in one place.
 - To spread things in different directions.

5. attract
- To repel or push something or someone away.
 - To draw or pull something or someone closer.

6. flexible
- Capable of bending or adapting easily without breaking.
 - Rigid or stiff; not capable of bending.

7. shiver
- To dance or move with excitement or joy.
 - To tremble or shake slightly due to cold or fear.

8. careless
- Extremely cautious and overly attentive to details.
 - Not paying attention or not cautious; inattentive.

9. signal
- A sign or indication used to communicate a message.
 - A random noise or action without any meaning.
