1. concentrate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To focus one's attention or mental effort on a specific task or objective.• To let one's mind wander and lose focus on the task at hand.
2. essential	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Absolutely necessary or fundamental; crucial.• Optional or insignificant; not necessary for the desired outcome.
3. represent	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To hide the true nature or identity of someone or something.• To act or speak on behalf of someone or something.
4. communicate	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To deliberately withhold or keep information to oneself.• To exchange information, ideas, or feelings through verbal or nonverbal means.
5. outstanding	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mediocre, average, or unremarkable; blending in with the crowd.• Remarkably good, excellent, or impressive; standing out from the rest.
6. manufacture	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To invent fictional stories or events without any basis in reality.• To produce or make goods or products, especially on a large scale, using machinery or manual labor.
7. generosity	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The quality of being kind or giving; a willingness to help or give to others.• The act of being selfish, stingy, or unwilling to share with others.
8. fragile	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Easily broken, damaged, or destroyed; delicate or vulnerable.• Strong, durable, or resistant to damage or breakage.
9. queasy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Feeling completely satisfied, content, and free from any physical• Feeling nauseated or sick to the stomach; experiencing discomfort or unease.
