| 1. modest | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Displaying excessive pride, arrogance, or self-importance in one's abilities or appearance.• Having or showing a moderate or humble estimate of one's abilities, achievements, or appearance. |
| 2. frontier | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The border of where civilization ends and where an unsettled area begins.• Heavily populated and well-explored area with no uncharted regions. |
| 3. plead | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To give orders or commands in a forceful manner.• To make an emotional or earnest appeal or request. |
| 4. valiant | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Displaying fear or a lack of resolve in challenging situations.• Showing courage, bravery, or determination in the face of danger or Difficulty. |
| 5. envy | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A feeling of discontent or resentment aroused by someone else's possessions, qualities, or luck.• A feeling of happiness and admiration for someone else's success or achievements. |
| 6. anxious | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A feeling of unease, such as worry or fear• Feeling completely calm and relaxed in any situation. |
| 7. circular | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shaped like a circle; round or curved in shape.• Shaped like a square; having straight edges. |
| 8. distress | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• A feeling of complete calmness, tranquility, or peace of mind.• Extreme anxiety, sorrow, or pain; a state of emotional discomfort. |
| 9. awkward | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Lacking skill, grace, or ease in movement or behavior; causing discomfort or embarrassment.• Displaying poise, gracefulness, and social confidence in any situation. |
